

■ Features of Nagasaki Port

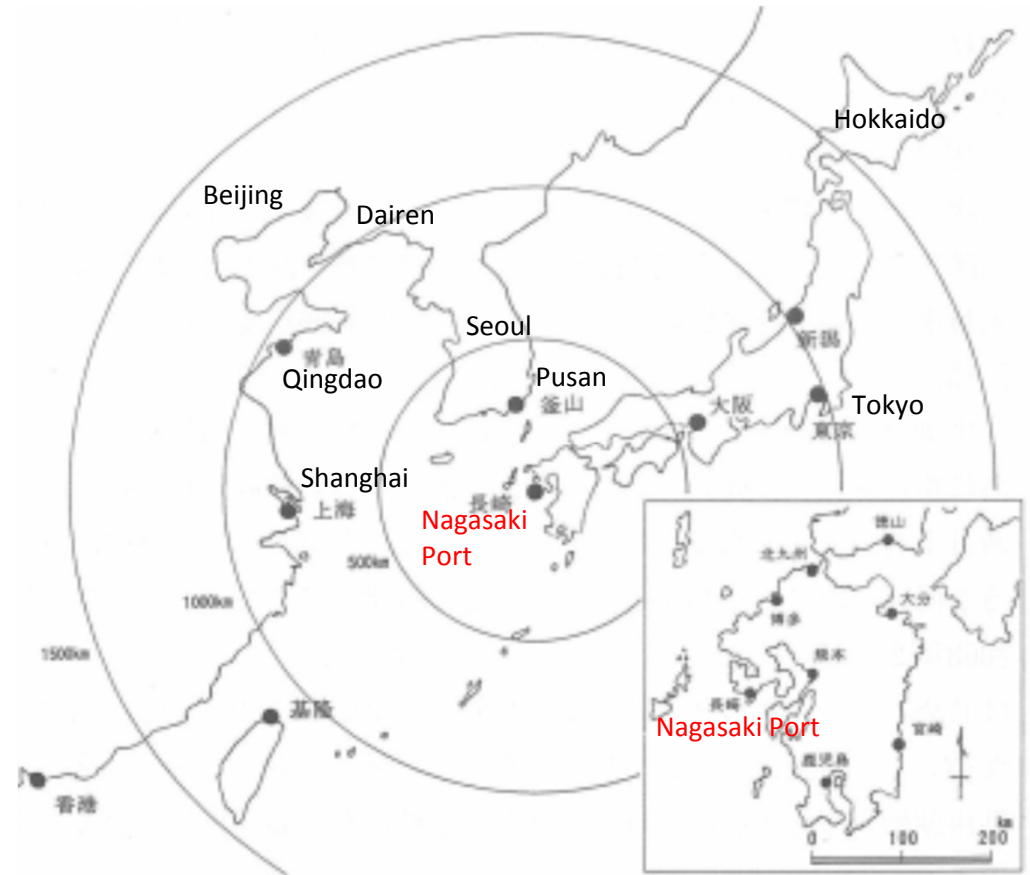
Nagasaki Port is located on the northwest tip of Japan. Culture and science from Asia and Europe have entered Japan through Nagasaki Port. In particular, Nagasaki Port was the only port open to exchange with overseas countries during the period of national isolation (1854-1868). Even now, many cruise ships still call at this port. Recently, economic exchange between Japan and Asian nations has increased. Nagasaki Port is gaining more and more attention as a major port city with a geographically advantageous location in the center of East Asia.

- Nagasaki Port plays an important role, carrying goods and people to the outlying islands of Goto, Kamigoto, Takashima etc.
- Nagasaki City has very little land, so the port has contributed to the development of the city in the form of reclaimed land.
- Every Year many international cruise ships call at Nagasaki Port to see the historical attractions.
- Nagasaki Port is home to Mitsubishi Heavy Industries Shipbuilding Plant.
